

Time Commitment for TL1 Program

The TL1 program is designed to augment your discipline-specific training. Prior to accepting this award, please be sure that you can commit to the full range of required activities itemized below.

- TL1 Student to Scholar meetings
 - 1.5 hours, ~ 9 times each fall and spring semester
 - Two required courses during the TL1 training program
 - Team Science
 - Ethical Conduct of Research
 - TREC Grand Rounds
 - One hour each month during the academic year
 - Scholars must take one additional self-selected course
 - Attend the Association for Clinical and Translational Science (ACTS) meeting in Washington, D.C. once during the two program years
 - Travel funds provided
 - Attend a second ACTS meeting OR attend another clinical or translational professional meeting
 - Must be approved by program directors
 - Meet with your PI at least every two weeks
 - Once per semester with program directors
 - Meet with career mentor at least once per year (a mentor will be assigned to you)
 - Complete required surveys related to evaluation of the program
 - Additional enriching activities include special courses through the Health Sciences Library, special topics in statistics and special lectures
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
